A landslide in 2009 plugged Ryder Creek, caused localized flooding, and destroyed the house. We now need to clean up all the sheds, debris etc before we can re-plant and restore the property. If your interested in coming out Friday July 15th or Saturday July 16th to

volunteer here are some of the things we need help with right now:

- Shed demolition (*smashing and bashing*)
- Invasive plant removal (*pulling and slashing*)
- Garbage clean up (*Picking and sorting*)
- Weed-eating (*Slicing and dicing*)
- Fence removal (*Pulling and rolling*)
