



Native Plant Sale Fundraiser – Plant Order Pick-Up Day Support

On **Saturday, May 11th**, we need help running our native plant sale pick-up day event - one of our most important fundraisers of the year! Join us for a three-and-a-half-hour shift to greet guests, load plant orders into vehicles, or help direct traffic for a smooth and efficient event.

This is a great opportunity to show your support for the FVC by assisting with our fundraiser!

Why It's Helpful

- Our fundraisers need volunteer support to be successful. You will be connecting plant sale customers with their plant orders and help load their cars. Your volunteer work will help us ensure that our Native Plant Sale runs smoothly!

Responsibilities

We will decide on the day of the event which role is best suited for you. There will be three roles to choose from:

- **Plant loader:** You will help find their order, match the order slip, and then assist the customer with loading plants into their vehicle. This position requires bending and lifting up to 20 lbs repeatedly. Attention to detail is essential to ensure that all orders contain the correct plants.
- **Greeter:** You will greet customers as they make their way into the plant order pick-up location. Check their name, ask them some questions, and help make this a pleasant experience for our supporters.
- **Traffic control:** You will help direct cars in and out of the single driveway entrance to the pick-up site. Did you dream of becoming an air traffic controller? This position is for you!

Training/Equipment

- All training will be provided on the day.
- Gardening gloves will be provided, but feel free to bring your own.
- Please, **bring your own refillable water bottle** (fresh drinking water is available).

Safety

- Dress appropriately for the weather as **we will be outside**.
- Sturdy footwear is strongly recommended.
- Hi-vis vests will be required and provided for all volunteers.





Setting and Location

- West Abbotsford. The exact location will be provided upon registration.
- We will be outdoors under a covered area.
- There is a port-a-potty available on site.
