



Volunteer Activity: Invasive Plant Species Removal

Are you someone who wants to make a difference for nature and the people of the Fraser Valley? Do you want to see invasive plant species being managed? If so, we want you on our team!

We're looking for energetic volunteers to help us with the restoration of Lane Creek in Mission.

The Work:

- This will involve removing invasive plants.
- Manually cutting, digging, and pulling invasive plants away from the forest floor, shrubs and trees. Removing roots where possible.
- Putting removed plants in piles, bagging and/or loading onto a truck.

Why It's Helpful:

- Mission's Lane Creek is home to plenty of wildlife. You will be helping keep the park in top condition for the wildlife that call the area home.
- The fight against invasive plant species is ongoing. Keeping these invasives controlled will help recent plantings to thrive and make it a beautiful space.

What To Expect:

- Rain or shine!
- Wear weather-appropriate clothing and sturdy footwear (hiking boots are recommended, the ground may be uneven in some parts).
- All training and tools will be provided on the day of.
- Bring your own refillable water bottle! Fresh drinking water will be provided.
