Volunteer Activity: Forest Invasive Plant Control

*Are you someone who wants to make a difference for nature? Do you want to see
invasive plant species being managed in a natural area?
If so, we want your help!*

The Work:

- This will involve removing invasive plants to clear the way for native species
- Manually cutting, digging, and pulling invasive plants away from the forest floor, shrubs and trees. Removing roots where possible
- Putting removed plants in piles

Why It's Helpful:

- The FVC's properties are home to plenty of wildlife
- Controlling invasive plants keeps the forest and streams healthy
- The fight against invasive plant species is ongoing. Keeping these invasives controlled will help recent plantings to thrive

What To Expect:

- Rain or shine!
- This event takes place in a forest without trails or facilities
- You will have to move through shrubs, climb over logs and under trees
- Wear weather-appropriate clothing and sturdy footwear (hiking boots are strongly recommended)
- All training and tools will be provided on the day
- Bring your own refillable water bottle and food
- Wild animals may be present
